

## **Pendleton District Maps and Oversize Materials**

This collection of maps, illustrations, plans and blueprints contain information South Carolina in general and Anderson, Oconee and Pickens counties, specifically. The descriptions below outline groupings of material. **Illustrations: Art, Promotional and Reference:** An open collection of materials, primarily of unknown provenance. Bulk of materials range from 1971-2000. Also contains undated materials and photocopies of older, manuscript materials.

**Topographic Maps:** PDC Topographic Map Collection is an open collection of topographic maps of unknown provenance. Dates of maps range from 1946-1983.

**Maps:** PDC Map Collection is an open collection of materials, primarily of unknown provenance. Dates of materials range from 1932-1971 and contain highway, county and state maps, illustrated maps, prints and maps noting historical references.

**Plans:** PDC Plans Collection contains plans for buildings and projects, primarily generated for Pendleton District Commission projects. Dates of materials range from 1970 to the present and include such sites as Stumphouse Tunnel, Hagood Mill, Hunter's Store, the Pendleton District Agricultural Museum and the Caldwell-Johnson-Morris House.

**Manuscript Maps and Oversize Materials:** These donated collections of maps and oversize materials will be arranged, described and placed on the Pendleton District Commission's website in "Small Collections" or as an individually described collection.
