Photo of Lt. Commander Daniel Sullivan (possibly Clemson alumnus), n.d. and framed Medal of Honor citation, 1920.

Anderson Library Association Records, 1928-1973

.2 linear feet

Records of Anderson Library Association, including charter, minutes from 1928-1957 and records and correspondence relating to the transfer of the library to building to the Pendleton District Commission for lease to the Anderson County Arts Center.

Anderson Telephone Directories, 1929, 1930, 1932, 1942

.2 linear feet

Four telephone directories from Anderson area. Various additions include entries for Greenville, Seneca, Pendleton, Iva, Starr, Walhalla, Westminster, and Clemson, SC.

5 copies of minutes from the Spartanburg Baptist Association. 2 copies of the Baptist publication "Advanced Quarterly."

This collection contains membership applications, information on the Southern Cross award from the Pendleton Chapter, UDC, notes on Civil War topics, possibly into the 1960s, photocopies of roll of Orr's Rifle's Sons of Confederate Veterans chapter and one letter, dated 1852.

Two love letters from J.M. Barr to Narcissus E. Orr with typed transcriptions.

Loring B. Hembree Collection, 1905-1962

2.4 linear feet

Materials relating to the city of Anderson, including editions of the Anderson Daily Mail, Anderson Independent and one issue of the African American newspaper The Herald (1959). Collection also includes Audrey Hembree's scrapbook, 1934 with images of buildings in Anderson and four photographs ca. 1900, including the Cedar Grove Singing Class, August 9, 1911.

Blue Ridge Railway Photograph Collection, 1941-1942

Photographs of the Blue Ridge Railway in Anderson County when Roland H. Martin was Roadmaster. Includes photos of trains in Anderson, as well as construction of trestle at Broadway Creek, and includes images of other employees. Collection also includes a file of news clippings.

.2 linear feet

10 Documents related to agriculture in Pendleton, includes references to Aull's Pendleton Oil and Fertilizer Company, Woodburn Stock Farm and Harris Hall Stock Farm.

Senator Nell Smith Collection, 1814-1847

.2 linear feet

Four land documents from Pendleton District and Pickens District. Includes the following names: John Bowen, David Hendricks, Matthew Mullinax, Elias Mullinax, Joseph Glover and Eppes Majors.

SC1990.7

Mary Sloan Collection, 1905-1957

Miscellaneous material relating to Pendleton and Clemson, SC. Includes Janie Gantt's postcard album, a 1908 Clemson College calendar, newspaper clippings about local history topics, a poster for "The Pendleton Loafers Club," several newspapers and three

photos. Names include Janie Gantt, Ella Sitton, J.V. Bostic, Sue Crawford and Mamie McC. Brown.

Iris Davis Agricultural Publications Collection, 1918-1943

.2 linear feet

5 individual agricultural publications, including a 1943 "War Edition" Texaco farm machinery manual.

James Webb Papers, 1860s-1880s

.2 linear feet

Legal papers associated with James Webb of Anderson County, estate papers of John Hix and Samuel Bowen, mortgage papers from John B. Whitten (indebted to Webb) and misc. notes on other debts held by Webb.

Seneca High School Sports Collection, Ca. 1924

.2 linear feet

Collection contains two photographs of sports teams, one poster, newspaper clippings and ephemera related to Seneca High School sports.

SC1997.1

Boleman-Herring Pendleton Photographs, ca. 1995

.4 linear feet

Photographs taken for locally produced newspaper, *The Pendletonian* in the mid-1990s. Collection contains prints and negatives of local individuals, businesses and events in the town of Pendleton.

Lily Strickland Sheet Music Collection, 1920, 1922

Two pieces of sheet music written by Anderson native Lily Strickland, "Mah Lindy Lou," 1920 and "My Lover is a Fisherman," 1922.

Three items: 1940 South Carolina Garden Club Bulletin, a framed notice of sale at J.S. Martin's store in Pendleton, 1903, and a commencement bulletin from Clemson College, 1927.

Robert Adger Bowen Correspondence, 1966

Three notes from writer and poet Robert Adger Bowen to Lee and Richard Watson. Also contains Lee Watson's letter of donation to Hurley Badders, PDC director. See Clemson University Special Collections for Bowen's papers.

Lewis, Poore and Moorhead Family Bible, 1843-1920  
Ca. 1843. Contains notations on families until 1920.

SC2001.3

Aull Photograph Collection  
1948-1955

24 photographs, given to Pendleton Mayor J.A. Aull by Wilton E. Hall, publisher of the Anderson Independent. Includes images of downtown Pendleton, town council and Mayor Aull, and construction projects around Pendleton.

SC2002.1

Original "Citizens Copy" of the deed to the town of Pendleton, Isaac Lynch to Justices of Pendleton County, April 8, 1790.

SC2005.1

"Lafrance Life" Newsletters, 1947, 1952

Two issues of "Lafrance Life" newsletter, published by Pendleton Manufacturing Company. April 1, 1947 and July, 1952.

Margaret Duncan Collection, ca. 1920s

Collection primarily consists of photographs of the Whitten-Foster family of Pendleton, SC circa 1920. Also includes a patent for an automatic loom shuttle and an example of the shuttle. Contains accounts from Medlock's Dry Cleaners in Pendleton.

1 book, *A Universal Biographical Dictionary Comprising the Most Eminent Characters of Every Age and Nation...* Harford, S. Andrus and Son, "Pendleton Library inscribed on cover.

Tim Drake Papers, 1822-1871

Miscellaneous papers related to Pendleton. Includes 2 letters to Thomas Pinckney regarding St. Paul's Episcopal Church (including a letter from Rev. Rodolphus Dickinson), a plat (1838) for Lot 12 (part of Lowther Estate) in Pendleton, and estate papers for David Beatty (1860s-1870s)

Iva Photographs, 1900-1950s

.4 linear feet

Collection created as a result of a "Pendleton District Commission Photo Day" in the 1980s, where residents of Iva, SC (Anderson County) brought historic photographs of the area to be photographed and placed in the PDC's Special Collections. Contains photographs labeled with subjects and owners.
